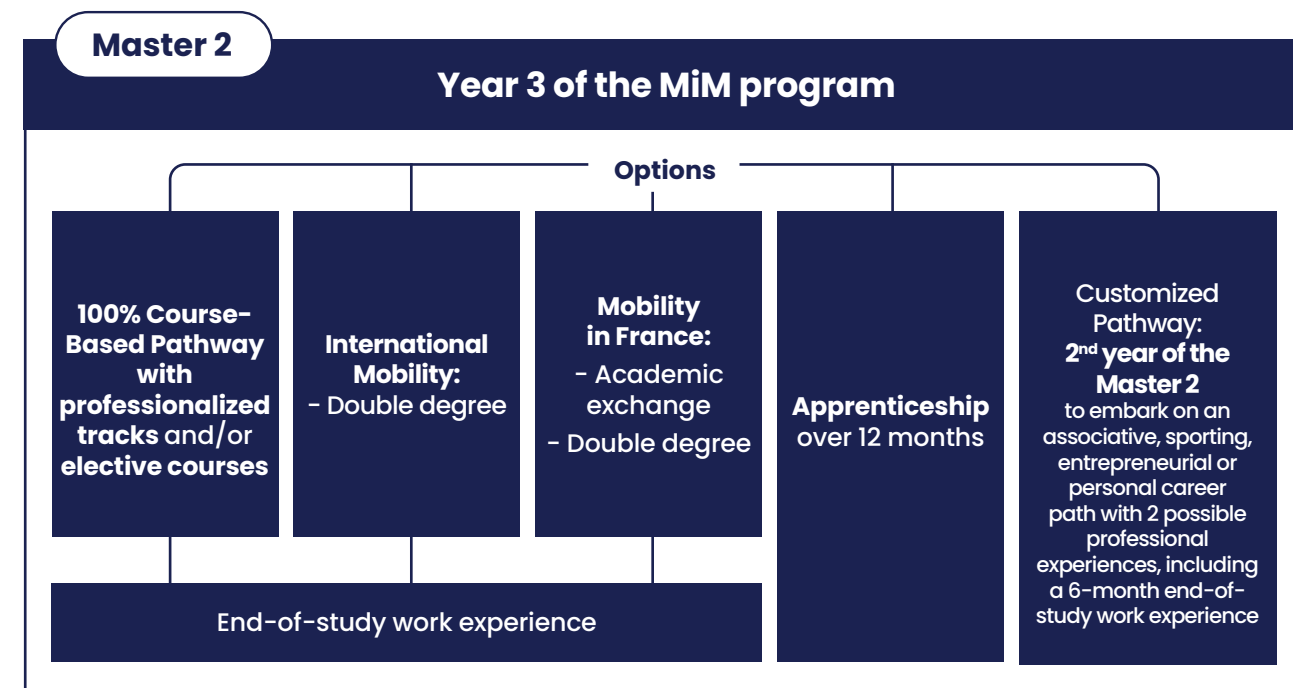

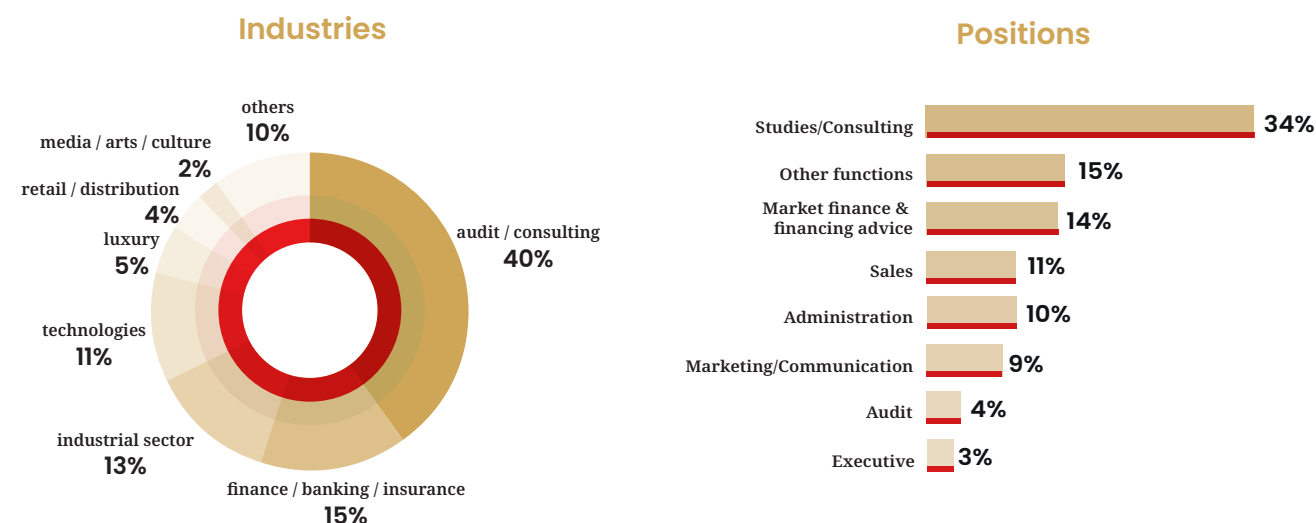

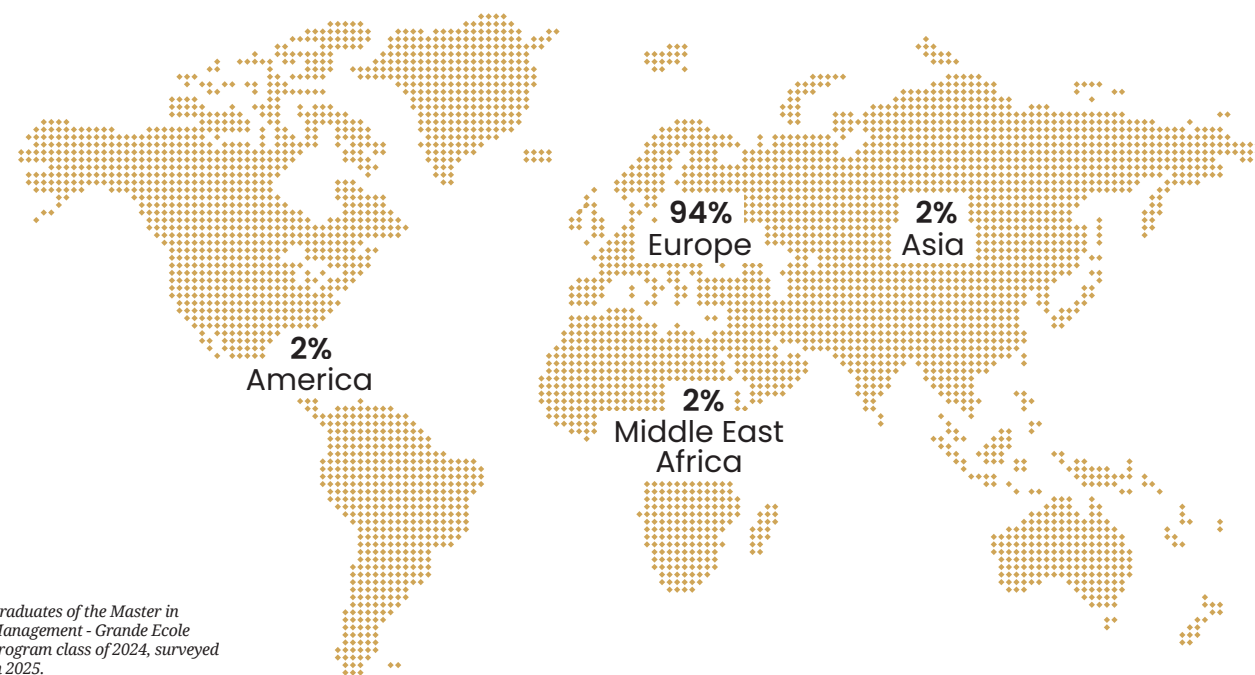

The strength of our incubator

For over 40 years, **emlyon venture labs** has been helping and supporting innovative entrepreneurs in their ideation and launch phases.

emlyon venture labs provides incubated start-ups with its expertise, its network and a set of proven tools and methodologies, offering pragmatic and concrete support for their success and long-term survival.

emlyon business school's entrepreneurial ecosystem is built on its faculty's cutting-edge research, strengthened by a network of over 90 top-tier experts and mentors, as well as a diverse range of strategic partnerships. This dynamic enables us to combine complementary skills and cross-disciplinary expertise in collaboration with incubators and accelerators, advanced research laboratories, engineering schools, companies, and institutions.

Start-up Track

The Start-up Track, offered in the second year of the Master's program, is designed for students looking to bring their entrepreneurial project to life. Led by professors, alumni, and expert entrepreneurs, it provides hands-on learning enriched by real-world experience, pitch training, and project workshops. At the end of this track, promising projects can join **emlyon venture labs** and benefit from personalized support.

Entrepreneur Academy

The Entrepreneur Academy's mission is to encourage the emergence and development of any type of project (technological or otherwise) that addresses issues or opportunities linked to environmental, social, technological, or digital change. Therefore, it is not a question of pitting start-up entrepreneurship against more traditional or residential entrepreneurship.

A long-term support program tailored to each student

Selected students will receive advice and support according to their project, their level of involvement in the project (a “side” or “full” project), their place of residence and their academic obligations.

They will have access to tailored mentoring, expert bootcamps delivered in hybrid mode, a digital library of expert content, a package of services negotiated with partners, strategic project reviews with the incubator-accelerator's board of directors, networking opportunities, etc.

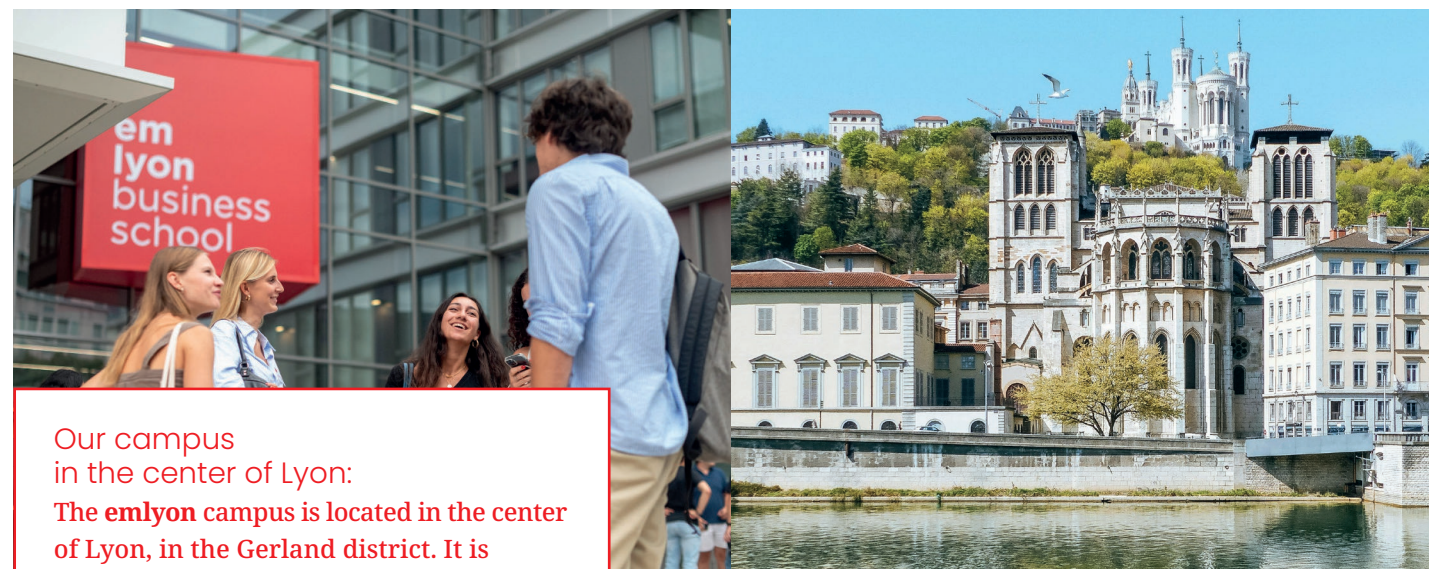
We hope that you will make the ISO your first stop whenever you have questions relating to your immigration status, but also when you are looking for information regarding your life in France or if you just need someone to talk to.

Lyon, a buzzing city

Land of opportunities

The metropolis has a particularly well-developed urban mobility and soft modes of transport: metros, tramways, buses, boats, self-service bicycles... In 2023, the NGO Clean Cities ranked it the 8th best city in Europe for sustainable mobility, and in 2025, The Economist ranked it the 5th most walkable city in the world.

Enjoy Lyon's cultural life

The city offers a wide variety of cultural activities and events, including the Nuits Sonores (international electronic music event), the Fête des Lumières (festival of lights), the Nuits de Fourvière (concerts and cultural events), etc.

Lyon also boasts numerous museums to satisfy your thirst for knowledge: Musée Cinéma et Miniature, Musée des Beaux-Arts, Musée des Confluences, Lugdunum - Roman museum and theatre, etc.

How much does it cost to live decently in Lyon?

Lyon is a big city, but the cost of living is moderate. Compared with Paris, the cost of living is 26% lower (source: OnlyLyon Business). Budget around €1,200 for your initial installation, including €600 for rent.

UNESCO has declared Lyon's historic urban site a World Heritage Site. From the Basilica of Fourvière to Vieux Lyon and Croix-Rousse, Lyon is renowned for its quality of life, rich culture, and renowned gastronomy, as evidenced by the traditional "bouchons lyonnais".

Crossroads of Europe, city of meeting and exchanges

Lyon is a real gateway to the world: all of Europe is under 2hrs away by plane and the airport offers service to over 120 destinations. It is 2hrs from Paris and 1h45 from Marseille by "TGV" high-speed train, and it is equidistant from the ski resorts of the Alps and the sea, both 2hrs away by car.

A competitive and cosmopolitan metropolis

Thanks to its strong entrepreneurial spirit, Lyon draws an ever-growing number of businesses and talents each year in France's 1st industrial region.

Lyon is home to not only major French companies with global operations (Sanofi-Pasteur, Bayer, Biomérieux, Groupe SEB, Renault Trucks, among others), but also international organizations (such as Handicap International, OMS, IARC and Interpol).

How to join us?

The Master in Management - Grande Ecole program allows the validation of the professional certification “DipViGrM - Programme Grande Ecole”, level 7, issued by emlyon business school and registered with the RNCP under number 38071 on 09/01/2023.

For students holding a non-French diploma equivalent to at least Bac+3 level (i.e. 3 years of post-secondary education)

This competitive entrance exam procedure works in two ways: *

☉ The “Join a School in France” consortium

- allows international students who have a Bachelor’s degree obtained outside of France to apply to the Master in Management of 5 Grandes Ecoles (HEC Paris, ESCP, **emlyon**, SKEMA, Audencia) with a single application.
- Three-year degree diploma minimum (Bachelor’s, Licence, Benke, etc.)
 - Management test (GMAT™ / GMAT™ Focus / GRE® / TAGE MAGE®)
 - English test (TOEIC® / IELTS® / TOEFL® / Cambridge)
 - 2 letters of recommendation
 - Academic transcript
 - Résumé (CV)
 - ID

Both admission procedures require a management test and an English test. Application sessions run from October to June.

* The two admission tracks for holders of a non-French diploma (Direct International Admissions and Join a School in France) are mutually exclusive.

Financing your studies

Scholarships

Scholarships granted by emlyon business school

As a socially responsible organization, **emlyon** business school helps students to finance their Master in Management - Grande Ecole by offering scholarships to qualifying students. These scholarships can help cover up to 60% of the tuition fees of the 1st year.

emlyon Foundation scholarships

emlyon business school Foundation may grant financial scholarship based on social, personal, and financial conditions. Application process are available on our platform at the beginning of the academic year.

Partner company scholarships

Each year, **emlyon** business school works with companies such as Biomérieux, Capgemini and Sanofi through sponsorship programs to provide financial support to our students in need.

Financing through apprenticeship

Apprenticeship allows your employer to fund your final year of study. Under the apprenticeship contract, the company

pays all tuition fees (except CVEC). The student also receives a salary during the apprenticeship year.
